In this regard, ITDC is seeking to engage a Consultant (DSC) to assist communities in identifying the infrastructure and services required in the area and prepare the detailed engineering design and bidding documents for the necessary infrastructure and supervise construction of such improvements.

The ITDC now invites eligible consulting firms ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. criteria):

- Having Urban Infrastructure Design as a core business and at least 10 (ten) years of operation;
- Having relevant experience at least two completed contracts in the last five years in managing the detailed engineering design of urban infrastructure development, commercial/industrial area development, commercial buildings, or road construction, preferably in tourism and infrastructure sectors;
- Having minimum average annual turnover in the past 5 years of IDR 4,950,000,000.00.

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to Section II, paragraph 4.4 of the AIIB Procurement Directive (June 2, 2016) ("Procurement Directive"), setting forth the AIIB's policy on conflict of interest.

Consultants may choose (but not mandatory) to associate with other firms (max. 3 firms) in the form of a joint venture or a sub-consultancy to enhance their qualifications. In case of an association, the EOI must explicitly specify whether the association is in the form of a Joint Venture (all members jointly and severally liable for the entire assignment), or Sub-consultancy. In case of joint venture, the member firm appointed to represent the joint venture must be clearly identified. Only the qualifications and experience of members of joint venture, but not of sub-consultants, shall be considered in the EOI evaluation process.

A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the National Competitive Selection - Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) method set out in the Procurement Directive.
